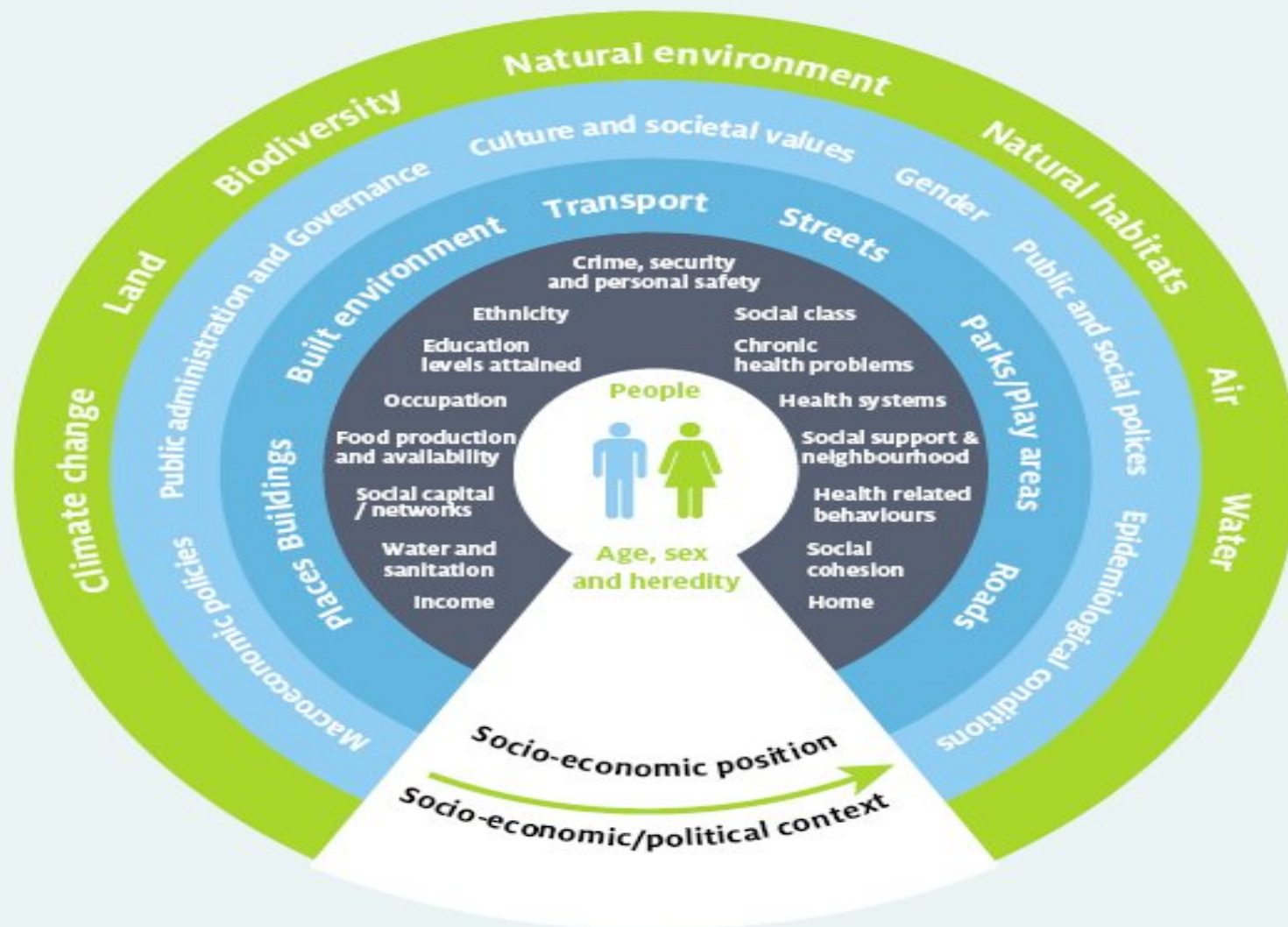

- Tool to provide an objective assessment
- Monitor and evaluate
- Engagement
  - Process
  - Outcomes
  - Indicators
- Key...Conceptualisation/understanding
- Life course

**Success: Health and wellbeing at top of everyone's mind / No one left behind**

**Outcomes**

**Responsibility is shared in addressing the social determinants of health and wellbeing**

**People of all ages and abilities participate in education, work and leisure activities to their full potential**

**Children are active and healthy, with positive physical and mental wellbeing**

**We live longer healthier lives in safe, healthy environments in resilient communities**

# Outcomes Framework...evolving process

## Phase 1: Working group

- International
- Conceptual model of health and wellbeing reflecting HI Goals

## Phase 2: Consultation Workshop

- Consensus domains, indicators
- Reconfigure conceptual model
- Stronger focus on wellbeing

## Phase 3: Task Focused Group

- International developments wellbeing
- Create and populate framework
- Consultation

# Components of an Outcomes Framework

- Domains in which we want to see change
- Determinants of health and wellbeing
  - Lifestyle and behaviours
  - Socio-economic factors
  - Living and working conditions
- Environmental threats and protective factors
- Health and social care
- Health status
  - Mortality
  - Morbidity
  - Wellbeing

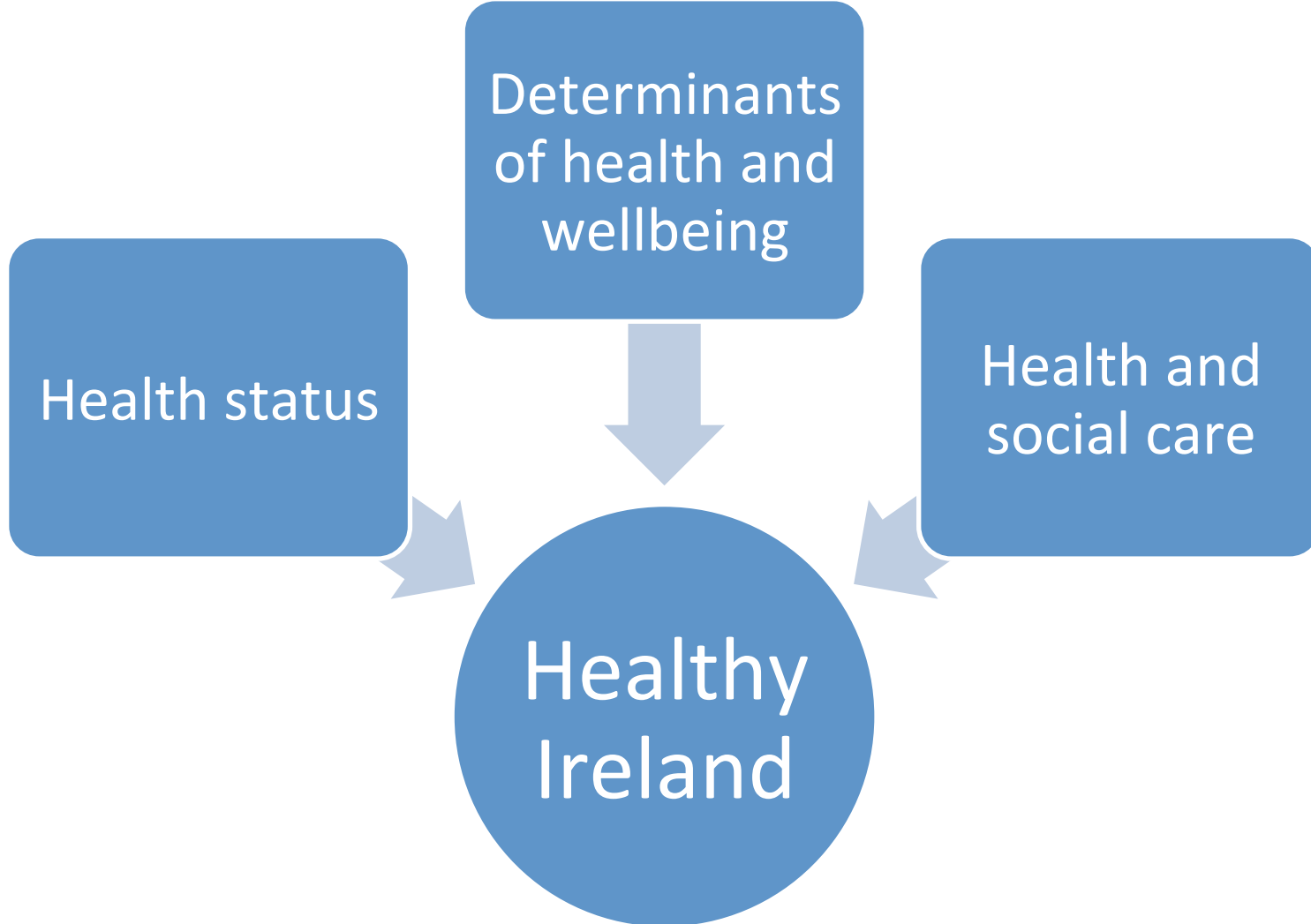
# Indicator selection

- Useful in the whole-of-government implementation of Healthy Ireland
- Useful /used in policy development or implementation
- Person centric
- Applicable /relevant across the life course
- Provide information for a wider audience, including the general public about the determinants of health

# Indicators

- Version 1
  - 28 indicators identified by a cross sectoral process
  - Reflect the social determinants of health and wellbeing across life course
  - Disaggregation
  - Health 2020, ECHI
- Publication
  - Simple clear message
  - Placeholders / Data gaps
- Highlights relationships, patterns and gaps
- Basis for a web-based visualisation element
